BRADY: I'm sure she'll call you soon.

Mom?

BRADY: Where are you going with this?

GABRIEL: I think maybe this is something Mom is thinking, not

something that's actually happening. You know how

she is.

BRADY: Do you think I'm stupid or something? I spoke to
